Symbiosis strives to achieve balance in the three pillars of sustainability - environment, society and the economy. We are working with **isla**, a non-profit organisation founded as the event industry's response to the climate crisis. Set-up by events professionals and industry leaders, **isla** is an action driven network. It brings together expertise from across the entire events sector, provides resources and training and has developed tools to support and deliver industry wide standardisation and best practice on sustainable practices.

As an **isla** member, we will focus on three core areas: zero waste, 100% renewable, and carbon emission reductions. Through facilitation, education and reporting we will share knowledge, upskill and track our progress in order to rapidly and meaningfully affect change across the whole business and across the industry.

Our documented approach is based on:

Identifying and satisfying compliance obligations and demonstration of best practice;

Identifying and managing environmental risks and opportunities;

Understanding and management of direct and indirect environmental impacts associated with our operations, products and services;

Focusing on pollution prevention, climate change mitigation and adaptation, responsible use of resources, waste avoidance;

Minimising the need for business travel and selecting products and services with reduced environmental impacts.

Assignment at all management levels of roles with defined responsibilities and authorities for compliance related requirements;



Provision of appropriate training and awareness programmes to help our colleagues identify, understand and minimise risks associated with their activities and therefore to identify and deliver opportunities that will achieve positive environmental outcomes;

Measuring, monitoring, auditing and targeting improvements in our environmental performance through objective and target setting, with appropriate corrective actions undertaken;

Forming allegiances with appropriate voluntary initiatives at a local, national or global level particularly those aligned with the 2030 global Sustainable Development Goals;
